BOTANICAL GARDEN

At the end of the Danube Coast is one of the most beautiful places in Galati - an impressive botanical garden that houses thousands of plant varieties, many of them protected or exotic. The Botanical Garden in Galati is part of the Museum of Natural Sciences Complex, which includes an aquarium with hundreds of fish and the most modern astronomical observer.



FORTIFIED CHURCH OF THE "HOLY PRECISTA"

The beautiful most panoramas in Galați can be admired from the Danube River. An emblematic place for this city, the Danube Cliff has plenty of entertainment options, from stunning walks along the river bank, to floating pontoon restaurants and vapors, various shows and a lot of sculptures.



Close to the Danube cliff we have a church, but not a simple one. Precista is the oldest touristic objective in Galati built between the years 1643-1646 it is actually a "Safe" place in case of war, being fortified. Being burnt and robbed by the otomans, destroyed by the Russian- Otoman wars it remains one of the oldest and greatest church here in Galati. If you like history and you want to feel like you were living in the mid 16's make sure to bring your notebook with you.

THE TOWER OF TELEVISION



Measuring around 100 meters in height we go to the television tower. A master-piece of modern engineering. The tower, completed in 1978, is equipped with a tower restaurant, perhaps the only of this kind in Romania. It was used to broadcast FM and TV.
