## What to visit?



- La Salette Park: with 17 hectares of leisure in a pleasant green scenery and the Chapel of Our Lady of La Salette:
- The major national and international sport events were held in Oliveira de Azeméis: football and hockey are the most popular.
- The train "Vouquinha": between Oliveira de Azeméis and Espinho-Vouga, gains a double life with the search of this means of transport by the populations to reach the beaches. It is an ancient train, that takes advantage of the beautiful landscapes.
